

**A Short History of
Holy Name of Jesus School**

In March of 1878, Fr. Thomas D. O'Reilly was charged by Bishop Loughlin to establish Holy Name of Jesus Parish. Seven years later, on June 24, 1885 our first elementary school opened.

The young school thrived under the direction and guidance of the Sisters of St. Joseph, Brentwood. In September 1923, a dream was fulfilled and a new larger school was opened. In 1924, the Xaverian Brothers joined the Sisters in educating the youth of the community. Under the direction and guidance of these religious men and women the school flourished for generations.

The 1970's were a time of change in the church and society. The Xaverian Brothers left the school, while the Sisters continued to reach out to and instruct the children of the parish. As members of the religious communities decreased, lay people began to fill their roles. A competent and dedicated lay staff has long since replaced the Sisters and Brothers. In 1994, the school welcomed its first lay principal. In 2008 Holy Name of Jesus School welcomed back its own graduates as Principal and Assistant Principal.

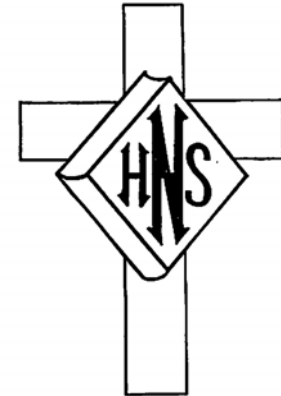
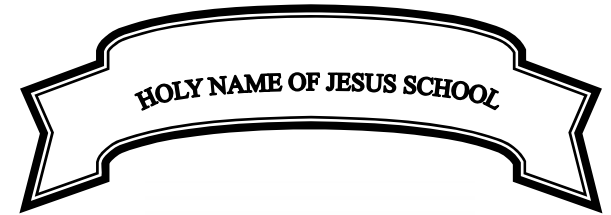
